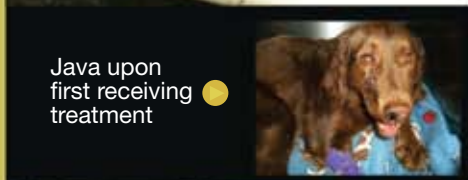

Brown Dog

Brown Dog – Side of road – Possibly hit by car.

When the County Animal Control Officer arrived on the scene, she found a dog with a head injury, covered in blood. The A.C.O. rushed her to the emergency clinic for some much needed medical care. What veterinarians found was shocking and not expected. This poor pup had not been hit by a car, but rather riddled with pellets from a shotgun blast.

Who would do such a thing? Why? Those questions will never be answered.

The vets did what they could to tend to her wounds and make her comfortable. Their thought was not to remove the pellets at that time.

Once back at the Orange County shelter, "Brown Dog" did not adapt too well. She was uncomfortable in a kennel and having trouble breathing and eating due to her injuries. Luckily for "Brown Dog," Pet Project Foundation has a Third Chance Program which enables us to rescue dogs from other shelters that might otherwise be euthanized. Chris Pernick, PPF Board member and owner of Paws Pet Resort, was looking for such dogs on a late night search on her computer. When she came across Brown Dog, she knew she had to get this girl and get her fast.

With full support of the Board of Directors, Chris rushed the next morning to pick up this dog and get her to a veterinarian for a full evaluation. The vet suggested at this time the dog be made as comfortable as possible and rest so that she could heal properly.

Chris took "Brown Dog" to her work where her first task was to give her a proper name, and Java it was. Slowly the healing process began for our sweet Java. Her recovery will take quite some time as her injuries are primarily to her facial area and esophagus, which hampers her eating and sometimes causes breathing problems. However the vets feel strongly that she will recover with love, care and attention, exactly what she has, thanks to her Third Chance.

Animal Control officer Jill Moran responded to a call on November 9th 2009.

A terrified and injured Chihuahua was found in a San Clemente beach community. She had cherry eye and a severely infected neck wound from an imbedded plastic bag creating a 3/4” gouge around her neck. She was also heavily flea ridden.

This terrified little dog was immediately transported to Estrella Vet Clinic where pain medications and sedation were administered in order to remove the bag. Akasha was bathed and flea treatments administered.

Akasha has now healed physically and is awaiting adoption; she still needs to gain back her confidence after such a traumatic experience and a quiet loving home would provide the best environment for that to happen.

"Ewwwww!" That's what some of us thought when two-month-old kitten Tucker came into the shelter on Sunday, June 28. He was thin, covered in fleas, had hair loss, and was crusty. A scraping was taken of his skin, and he was diagnosed with mange. He was anemic and, to top it off, was diagnosed with coccidia. Could it get much worse?

The long treatment process began, during which time Tucker was isolated from the other cats in the shelter and the volunteers. On August 10, he became ready for adoption. But were we ready for Tucker? All those lonely days in isolation, Tucker now needed socializing.

Kittens learn from other kittens through play that biting hurts. Tucker didn't get the benefit of sibling kittens during the time he was in isolation. He came out of it as a rough-playing, bite-crazy kitty. Being held by a human was an over stimulating event for Tucker, and he reacted by biting hands. Cindi Kane taught the volunteers how to work with him, holding him every day, teaching him not to bite by substituting a little stuffed animal for our hands when he took to biting. Or using our long finger nails on the roof of his mouth when he tried to pierce us with his sharp teeth. My favorite, stuffing his own paw in his mouth just as he tried to clamp down on my hand. That soon got his attention!

Amanda Blackburn came to the shelter to find a playmate for her over exuberant kitty Duncan. "My kitten has the same issues, and we're working with him also." She listened to the tips that Cindi had given the volunteers as she held Tucker. Love was growing. "This is the kitten I've been looking for." Not only was Tucker getting a great human, but he was going to have a play buddy!

I'll let Amanda give you the update:

"Tucker has been a WONDERFUL addition to my home! He's also just what my older kitty, Duncan, has been waiting for. After the first day of sniffing and growling, the two are now inseparable and love to wrestle and chase each other around, when they aren't snoozing or eating. He's only nipped at me a few times when he gets over-stimulated during play time, but giving him a toy to bite on or walking away seems to be working. Other than that, he's absolutely one of the sweetest kittens I've come across. He loves to be cuddled and purrs up a storm...I can tell he's going to be a lap cat, because when he's not playing with Duncan, he's curled up next to me. Thank you again for helping me find my new kitten!" ■
